Ukrainian Mission Work (UMW) continues to make progress as it begins its transition to ministering to more rural communities and villages in Ukraine.

Currently, UMW directors are screening applicants to be included on their initial trip into these expanded areas the first few weeks in July. According to Max Pratt, UMW Director, "the areas we have targeted are rural areas around towns and cities which UMW has been working for the past several years, primarily the cities of Kiev and Sumy."

The decision to move into the rural areas of Ukraine came after Timothy Johnson, former Missionary to Ukraine, made an exploratory trip and found that the Ukrainian rural communities have not been targeted by many Christian efforts. "I found that while there are literally hundreds of really good Christian mission efforts in Ukraine, there are very few that reach out from the major cities. And, while the urban areas are growing more resistant to the Gospel message, the rural areas are still very receptive!" Johnson said.

UMW is quick to point out that the focus on rural areas is just part of the UMW change in strategy. Timothy Johnson also points out that on his last trip he made contact with some evangelist who were converted while being incarcerated in the Ukrainian prison system. It is hoped that UMW will partner with them, local churches in the targeted areas, and other mission works to help evangelize a much larger area than before. "Our mission has not changed," says Max Pratt. He continues "our mission statement is and continues to be that we will go into all the world making disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey the teachings of Jesus."

UMW plans to have an aggressive Bible distribution program which is aimed at encouraging recipients to contact a local congregation, or an evangelist. "Since day one we have focused on making the word of God available, trusting in the power of the Word to lead people to God" said Timothy Johnson.
