# THE BIBLE

I grew up in the Lutheran church and only attended services until my confirmation around age eleven. Though I was just a kid, I don't remember a single time we opened the Bible during service. My memories of church include:

- 1) memorizing the proper sayings you are required to repeat back to the Pastor when he says a particular line;
- 2) how to line up and kneel properly for communion; and
- 3) trying to figure out how in the world you are supposed to maintain a "smile" while singing in choir.

One Christmas I was gifted a Bible and couldn't even believe how cool it was. I started reading the Bible out loud to the dogs and my family thought I had lost my mind. After that, I grew almost intimidated by the Bible.

I avoided returning to church because I had never fully read the Bible, and certainly didn't have anything memorized in it. The thought of someone potentially asking me what my favorite verse is was too overwhelming for me. It wasn't until I started dating Max that I returned to church. Even now, eleven years later, I am still intimidated by the thought of attending bible studies for fear of people judging my lack of knowledge and thinking I'm not "Christian" enough.

Though I've continued to read more and more of the Bible throughout the years, I still haven't finished it. There is so much of it I don't understand or even comprehend and I start to feel discouraged.

This outline helped me understand the grouping of books and that it can be more beneficial to read it out of order. Additionally I've learned that no matter how many times you read the Bible, you can always interpret things in various ways. No matter how intimidated I get, the important thing is to just keep trying. Each Christian continues to learn no matter how far they are in their journey.
