The Armor of God

Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the Devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. I Peter 5:8.

Most of us have watched nature films that show the hunted and hunter in real life survivor action. The lion who is trying to catch his pray. The narrator tells us why the captive animal became dinner. It was physically hurt, sick, the slower runner, a young one who did not have the skills to evade the lion.

Sometime around AD 63, Peter wrote to the Christians in Asia Minor to encourage them in their faith and to remain close to God in spite of persecutions. Thus, we have His warning about the devil being like a lion, seeking anyone he might take away from the family of God, for us to be alert and self-controlled. So let us look at our weakness and see how we can stop the devil's attempts to take away our salvation.

I Peter 2:2 Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it, you may "grow" in your salvation.

II Timothy 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed, and who correctly handles the word of "Truth."

Ephesians 6:10-17¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to



stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Your enemy, the Devil, is looking for a Christian to devour. Don't let him get to you. God's word tells us what we need to overcome his efforts.

II Timothy 1:12 Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to Him for that day.

God will keep us. Our obligation is to know God's word and plan for us. Do not allow the devil to take away your salvation.


