## **Ruth**

Ruth was a woman who chose faith over fear. She chose to follow Naomi, her mother-in-law, to a foreign land where neither she, or Naomi, were guaranteed a safe future. Scripture says that Ruth clung to Naomi. Their relationship must have been a very loving one for Ruth to go with her knowing how uncertain their future would be.

Ruth probably worried about what would happen to Naomi. The culture at that time was not friendly to women. Women were not allowed to prosper without a man to oversee the estate. Two women would not be able to do much with the land that belonged to Naomi's husband and his family. So why did Ruth go? I believe that Naomi had shared her belief in God with Ruth, and she had accepted Him as her God as well. She not only clung to Naomi but to her faith in God to provide for both of them.

By working hard in the fields gathering the "left-overs", Ruth not only helps provide for Naomi, but catches the attention of Boaz who was considered Naomi's family redeemer. Naomi has Ruth request Boaz to "cover" her with his cloak. By doing so, Boaz makes a promise to take care of her.

There is some symbolism here. For instance, just as Boaz was the redeemer of the family. Jesus is our redeemer, and he covers us with His blood. We should cling to Him as Ruth clung to Naomi. Ironically, Jesus was a descendant of Ruth. Ruth's faith led to her redemption, and she is rewarded with a family, which was included in the lineage of Christ.

Last Wednesday our mid-week bible study began Season 1 of “**The Chosen**”

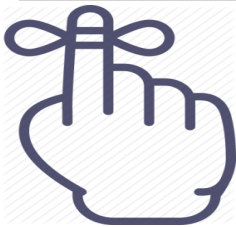
