GOD IS ON HIS THRONE

Several years ago, I heard my daughter say something from the back seat. “Look at the moon. It’s following us.” As a child, in the back seat of our four-door sedan, I also witnessed this white circle and its odd behavior. Like my daughter, I fell for the illusion that it was following me.

As I grew older I was interested to learn Earth/Space Science. One of my favorite topics in this class was astronomy; the study of anything in space, including our own planet, which hangs in nothingness, alongside the rest of the celestial bodies. In this class I learned that the moon wasn’t actually following, but that the moon revolved around the earth as it rotated, and the earth also revolved around the sun. My mind was officially blown.

Talk to some scientists, and they’ll say this has been going on for billions of years, others, say 10s of 1000s of years. Regardless of the exact time, one can surmise that the moon will continue following us in our vehicles, and decide to take a day or two off here or there, depending on weather.
