HOME WITH GOD

As I was debating on what to write about this week, it was very hard not to think about what we have been going through the past few weeks and months. As I looked at the lists of people that came to Andrea's service, of people that sent cards, pictures, letters, food, texts, money, words of encouragement, prayers, and things I cannot remember right now. The one thing that I would like to talk about is the "Patient Board" that was in Andrea's hospital room that she spent the last few days in.

First let me say that most hospitals are set up for those who are going to get well enough to leave that facility. They have been trained to fix people. It is not in their nature to give up. So, the "Patient Board" is designed to have information with that in mind. Information like "Planned Dismissal Date," "Pain Level," "New Medications," "Goals For The Day," "Discharge Plan," and things like that. For Andrea to be in the situation that she was in, the Doctors and Nurses did not know what to write in these areas. With these areas all left blank, on a day that Andrea spent most the day sleeping, my children and I started filling in the blanks with things that we thought appropriate. As we were writing I figured one of two things was going to happen. The first thing was that I would get in trouble with one or more of the nurses because we were not using the board for the purpose it was designed. Second was Andrea would wake up and tell us to stop messing with things and leave it alone. What happened was neither. I think the nurses were too afraid of me to say anything about it. And Andrea did wake up for a little bit that day and looked at it then started to tell us changes that we needed to make. You see in the place that said, "Discharge Plan", I wrote "Heaven". That was not clear enough for her. She instructed me to change that to "Home with God." There is a difference there. Heaven is not just some place we go, some vacation resort, some temporary stop on our journey. Heaven is home. It is the home. Our final home. — Dean Corder

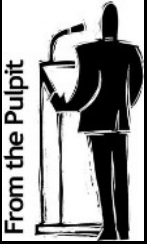
