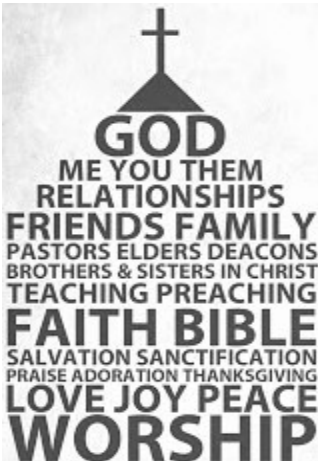

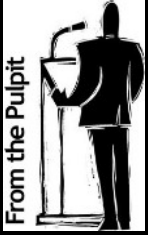
ARTICLE

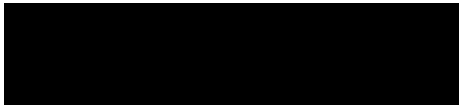
