The Test of Time

Earlier in the week I boxed up all my things. When I was done, I did a quick scan around my office and noticed it looked rather bare; even hollow. I glanced in the back of my van and noticed how little space seven years takes up. There was a part of me that pondered the question, “Have I accomplished anything?”

Moving brings out the nostalgia and reflective nature within most people. While packing I was reminded of a scripture written by Paul in 1 Corinthians 3. He talks about how Apollos watered, he planted, and, because of God, growth occurred. I naturally thought of ministers like George, Bob, myself, and the next guy.

Paul then changes from a metaphor about a field to one about a building. He says that he laid the foundation, but that someone else will build upon it. They may build something made of wood, gold, or silver, but whether it was foundational will be decided by time. “If anyone’s work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.”

Every minister that has worked at Westworth has built onto that foundation and hopes their work was, itself, foundational; standing the test of time. I could write a list of the things I think were foundational, and then beg for their continuation, but I think that would somehow ruin the natural transition of time’s test.

A good use of this transitional time would be for you to prayerfully ask, “Is there anything Nathan did, started, or spoke of that I feel especially called to help with?” If the answer is a yes, then that something may be exactly what the congregation needs to begin growing God’s Kingdom even during a pandemic. Afterall, didn’t our God grow the early church during a time of mass persecution?

I fully expect someone to attempt to tell me I was effective, and I appreciate the sentiment. BUT the answer to my effectiveness cannot be given today or even tomorrow. It can only be given through the test of time.

Recently one of my favorite theologians, Ravi Zacharias, was able to go be with Jesus. I heard a story about him and the first evangelist he added to the RZIM team which was affectionately called “elder brother.” Whenever the two of them saw one another, there would be a moment where they would say, “Looking unto Jesus, let us run.”

Paul ran well. Ravi ran well. I pray that you and I will both run well. You will always be in my prayers. - **Nathan Keller**
