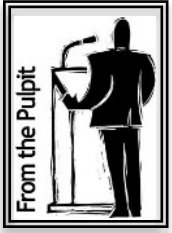
faith. These three pillars of life, that we all too often take for granted, are the bedrock of our civilization and have sustained generations of people through times we can't even imagine.
