Sing To The Lord

I wonder if some of the songs we've been singing for years and years that we still have no idea what the words mean. Or, that we simply don't pay attention to the meanings of the words we sing. I know I sometimes fall in that category. We get so wrapped up in the music and how it sounds that we lose focus on the words. And then we lose focus on actually applying the words.

When we sing today, try to focus on why we're singing. Are we doing it for our own pleasure? Or are we singing for the Lord? Ephesians says, "speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your hearts to the Lord" (5:19).

It doesn't matter what the music sounds like. It doesn't matter how fast or how slow the song leader is going. What matters is that we are singing for the Lord. The meaning of the music is in the words and in our hearts. Sing out and sing loud because we are pleasing the Lord with our voices. "And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus" (Col. 3:17).
