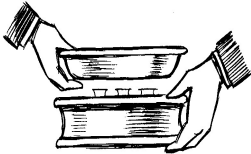

Surely Goodness and Mercy

On Friday I had the honor of attending the memorial service of our beloved Marge Kreger. As we gathered around the graveside to say our goodbyes, Brother Ronnie Cope talked about a passage that is at the end of the 23rd Psalm.

“⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life:” - KJV

I think a lot of times as we look at this Psalm, we get to the last verse and we run right through it. And that is understandable. There is so much in the first five verses and you get to the last verse, and it seems so simple. So we take it as it seems. As Brother Ronnie pointed out to us, there is more to the word “follow” than we normally think. When I think of the word follow, I think of someone following me to my house or me following someone to a restaurant that I have never been too.

Youngs Literal Translation puts it this way:

“Only -- goodness and kindness pursue me, All the days of my life,” - YLT

Pursue is a much different word to me than follow. As opposed to “Goodness and Mercy” following me around, and I can get them when I need them. Goodness and Mercy “Pursue” me. They chase me down. As soon as realize I am needing Gods blessings, I discover that His blessings have chased me down and taken care of me, before I knew I needed them.

God is not just close to us when we need him. He is always pursuing us with blessings. I do not know about you, but this gives me great comfort.
