The brevity of life was never on display more to me than last Sunday after church. Lanette and I were driving, after services, and a three car wreck occurred right in front of us. I don't think anyone was killed but the sudden violence of the situation just takes your breath away. We were directly behind the vehicles that wrecked, and it makes you realize how fast everything can change, almost in the blink of an eye.

That same evening, we were getting ready for bed and we heard a siren in our neighborhood. It got louder and louder and Lanette said, " that's right outside our house." We went outside and directly across from us we saw police cars, an ambulance and emergency lights going crazy. We eventually saw that they were bringing out our neighbor and friend from across the street on a stretcher. We have known this woman for years and she has always been so kind to us. Her son, who lives a few houses down, was following the stretcher as it came out of the house. He stayed with her until she was placed in the ambulance. When he saw me standing there he came over and said he had called to tell her goodnight but when she didn't answer he had walked over to her house to check on her. He said he found her on the floor, unconscious and blue. We talked a couple more minutes and then he left to follow the ambulance to the hospital. The next day we found out our friend had died.

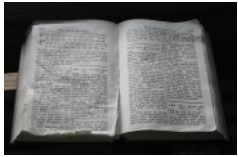
