We get mail...

Since I've been working at the church, I have come to realize how many resources and publications/documents are received here that serve to inform of what other churches are doing to grow the kingdom and give hope. Many of these are available for subscription if you review and find you would like to have it delivered to your home. Just to name a few:

- ***The Christian Appeal*** – most of you are familiar with this booklet of essays. Curtis Shelburne is the primary author of these essays that are simply written, but invariably carry a message from which we can all benefit.
- ***Power for Today*** – published by 21st Century Publishing, on a quarterly basis. This is one of my favorites. There is a page for each day of the quarter. Each page includes a recommended Scripture reading, a “mini-sermon”, a recommended hymn and a brief prayer. This is a great way to start each day.
- ***The Search Light*** – a newsletter from Edmond Church of Christ in Edmond, Oklahoma. This group also has a television ministry broadcast locally on KDFI Channel 27, 7:30 am Sundays. We receive only one copy of this newsletter, but they are on the North Foyer bulletin board, and you are welcomed to take one to review, and return when you are done.
- ***House to House/Heart to Heart*** – a newsletter published by East Ridge Church of Christ, East Ridge, Tennessee. There are always good, thought provoking articles in this publication. Again, we receive only one copy, but feel free to pick it up to review and return when you are finished.
- ***Christ for Today*** – another publication we began to receive, fairly recently. Published quarterly with articles certainly applicable to the Christian walk. For instance, in the most recent copy, on page 3, “*Science Makes the Case for God*”. Worth your time. They also have a website where you can access past versions of their publication. <http://www.christfortoday.org/>
- ***India Missions*** newsletter – This is a mission under the oversight of the elders at the Shiloh Church of Christ in Hazel Green, Alabama. Again, a source of concise information about the Church of Christ efforts in India.
- ***Healing Hands International*** – a newsletter. This organization does many good works internationally: ***Water Wells*** in places where the residents have never experienced clean water. Westworth has contributed to this effort in the past. ***Hunger to Harvest*** - providing instruction on basic gardening techniques that can be used even in drought-prone areas. ***Magi Project*** - Another of the HHI programs in which Westworth has participated. The majority

of MAGI boxes are given to local churches and missionaries to distribute in impoverished communities . A number of other programs are overseen by HHI. Take a look at their website at www.hhi.org for more information.

- **Action** – A newsletter published bi-monthly by the non-profit ministry of World Bible School, in Cedar Park, TX. Website: worldbibleschool.net. The Action Newsletter is available online at <https://www.worldbibleschool.net/action/>. Ministry site: worldbibleschool.net
- **Spiritual Sword** – this quarterly publication comes addressed to George Gray. That tells me we've been receiving this for this for a very long time. It is published by the Getwell Church of Christ in Memphis, TN.

So... As you can see, there are MANY good works being done. I hope you can take the opportunity to review the information we receive, either the paper copies, or visit the associated websites to get even more information. Perhaps it will inspire you. Or... If you have a good work in mind that can be shared with the congregation so that our talents will not lie dormant, but rather are vibrant for the glory of our Lord and Savior, please let it be known.
