# ***IT IS FINISHED!***

John 17:4 and John 19:30

Jesus is praying to His Father in all of John 17. In verse 4 he says, "I have glorified thee on the Earth. I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do." In chapter 19, Jesus was on the cross and said, "I thirst." Verse 30 states "When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, "It is finished," and He bowed His head and gave up the ghost.

It is finished. Done. Complete. Over. Nothing else needs to be accomplished. Every prophesy about the Savior who was to come to Earth has been fulfilled.

So just exactly what is "IT?" For us to have salvation and lead a Christ-centered life, we must understand "IT." God's plan for the redemption of man is "IT." God the Father. God the Son. God the Holy Spirit. The Trinity. Salvation for man came about through the sacrifice of the Son. The Holy Spirit came to guide and support man in his walk toward salvation. There are three distinct parts of the Trinity, all working for the salvation of mankind. Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I. Matthew 18:20.

Satan, the great deceiver, works through man's self-image. Remember how you doubt God's plan? Oh, it's a good plan. It just won't work for me. I'm not a good speaker. God doesn't have time for me. I can't do the things He asks me to do. God says we can do all things through Him. Remember, when you think you can't do something God has asked you to do, He has promised that all things are possible through Him. "IT" is finished for all believers.
