## THINGS I SHOULDN'T EXPECT FROM CHURCH

### 1. Perfection

### 2. Status Quo

Change is good and keeps us from worshipping "relics to the past" or making idols of things that are not of God, Change can flush out some of our false motives and old tendencies. ### 3. Getting My Way

This can manifest itself in a church when we have our own agenda, when we don't get to do what we want to do or when things are different than what we like. One of the great benefits of a church is that it teaches us to submit our way to the Lord's way and to trust the Lord. When we don't get our way it's our chance to exercise our faith and die to ourselves, which helps us grow in God;s way. **Don't expect to always get your way in church.**

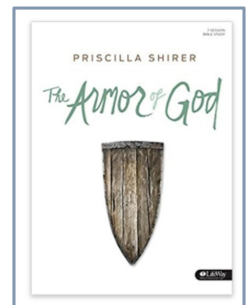
