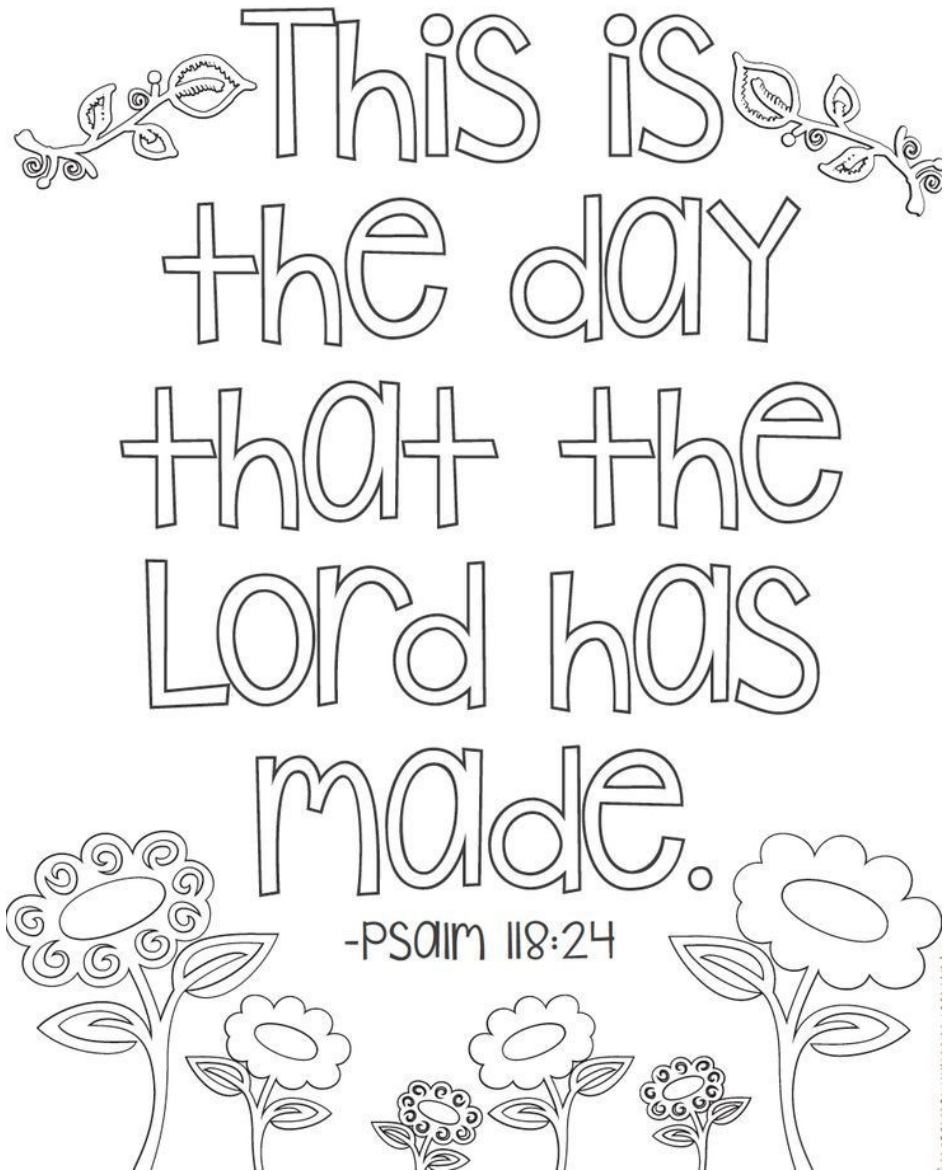
With restrictive visitation policies, I believe a card would help lift his spirits.

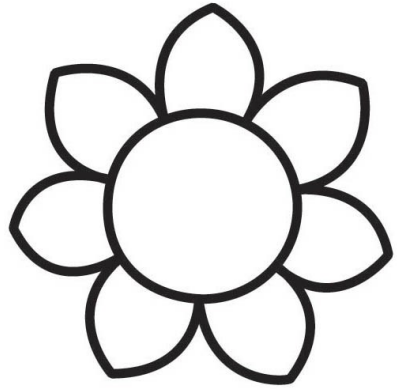

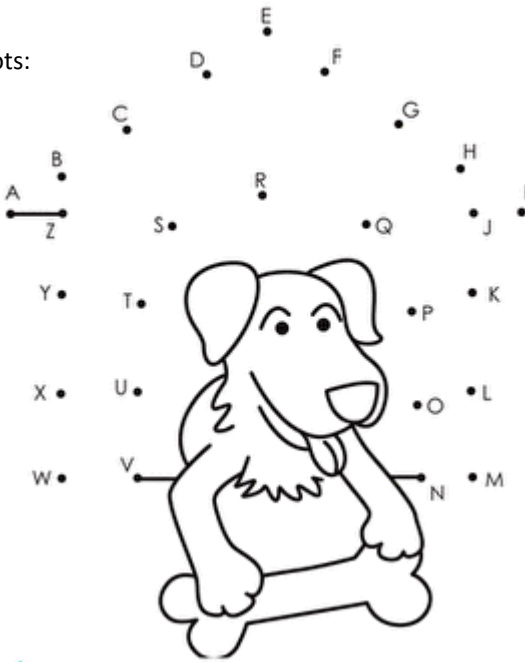
