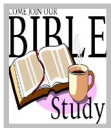

BEAUTIFUL FEET

Honestly, the thought of feet being “beautiful” is a concept very foreign to me. Feet... at their best, in my opinion... are functional and a blessing from God to carry us about. But “beautiful”... not so much. I’m thankful for feet that are functional, and usually get me where I want to go. However, they haven’t held a place of honor in my mind because they were too often a source of misery.

The two scriptures below paint a much different picture though.

Isaiah 52:7

*How **beautiful** on the mountains are the **feet** of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, “Your God reigns!”*

Romans 10:15

*And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How **beautiful** are the **feet** of those who bring good news!”*

These scriptures are the foundation of an organization in Ft. Worth—dedicated to helping the homeless and poverty stricken citizens. Some of what they do:

- Serve meals twice daily to homeless and needy
- Provide clothing to those in need through donations
- Provide a medical clinic 2 days each week, and a dental clinic one day each week
- Outreach to at-risk children for growth and development through bible studies, camps and yearly mission trips

- Outreach ministries—on and off the streets of Ft. Worth.
- Men's & Women's discipleship programs.

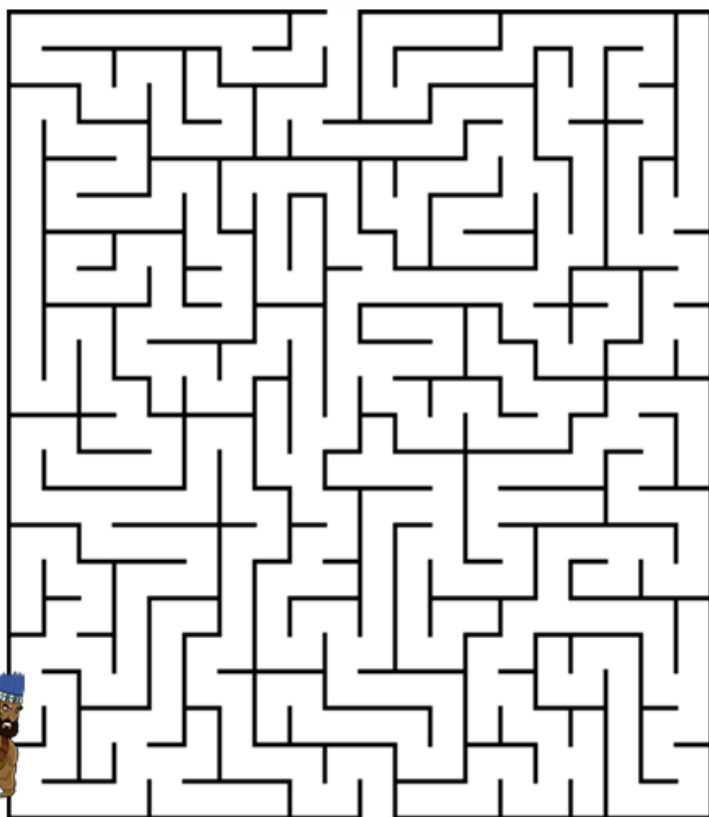
