


WELCOME VISITORS! Thank you for joining us today to worship the Lord.

"Give thanks to the Lord, for his is good. His love endures forever. Give thanks to the God of gods. His love endures forever. Give thanks to the Lord of lords: His love endures forever.....Give thanks to the God of heaven. His love endures forever."

In between those opening verses and the final one a recalling of the Heavenly Father's glory and how it has been shown. God's divine love is everlasting to everlasting. By knowing His love, we should be moved to open our hearts with gratitude for every blessing. James tells us that:

"Every good and perfect gift comes from above, coming down from the Father of heavenly lights, ..."(Jas. 1:17)
