BE STRONG & COURAGEOUS

Moses led the Israelites from slavery and through the forty years of wanderings in the wilderness. God had been with him all the while. Now the time had come for a new leader over God's house. It would be Joshua. He had taken the same journey from Egypt to the Jordan. Before Moses ascended the mountain to view the land of promise, he encouraged Joshua. He said, *"Be strong and courageous,....The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." Deut. 31:7,8.*

In some form or another the Lord spoke to Joshua to ready the people in crossing the Jordan River into the land God had promised Abraham. Hear the words God spoke: *"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:7-9.*

From Moses and now from the Lord Himself, Joshua has been given words of encouragement in his new task of leading God's people. One must notice that God had provided directions for Joshua to follow in the Law of Moses. Joshua was not left on his own to figure out how to do God's will. The promise was that if he kept the word in mind and heart, he would find success.

The same is true for all who follow in the footsteps of Jesus. We have confidence that all is well with our souls if we have taken his word and applied it to our lives. Jesus said of his words that they are spirit and life. To overcome the fears that could trouble us, we fill our hearts with the assurance that comes from the word of God. We must also be strong and courageous in living by faith in the Son of God.



Current Study: If by Mark Batterson. "Trading Your 'If Only' Regrets for God's 'What If' Possibilities"

Most recently we looked at Matthew 18:23-24, 35. It is about a man who owed 10,000 talents. Mark Batterson provided this comparison with the currency exchange of today:

Talent = 60 minas [or 180 months (15 yrs) wages] Mina = 3 months wages 10.000 talents (what the man owed) = 150.000 years of wages 150,000 years in todays life expectancy would be 2,232 lifetimes Annual income = \$15.080. Minimum wage today = \$7.25/hour Annual income x 150,000 years of wages = \$2,262,000,000.00 (That's **B**illions) The take-away: This is your value to God in today's currency. Give that a few minutes to soak in.
