Current Study: <u>If</u> by Mark Batterson. "Trading Your '**If Only**' Regrets for God's '**What If**' Possibilities"

Most recently we looked at Matthew 18:23-24, 35. It is about a man who owed 10,000 talents. Mark Batterson provided this comparison with the currency exchange of today:

Mina = 3 months wagesTalent = 60 minas [or 180 months (15 yrs) wages]10,000 talents (what the man owed) = 150,000 years of wages150,000 years in todays life expectancy would be 2,232 lifetimesMinimum wage today = \$7.25/hourAnnual income = \$15,080.Annual income x 150,000 years of wages = \$2,262,000,000.00 (That's <u>B</u>illions)The take-away:This is your value to God in today's currency.Give that a few minutes to soak in.
