ੈ Live by the Spirit ੀ

The Holy Spirit of God will guide us. His influence directs our steps toward God. Jesus promised a comforter or one who would counsel. When the apostle Paul gave us the instruction to not "*Grieve the Holy Spirit*", his purpose was that we do not reject His urgings leading us to our heavenly dwelling. The following instructions from the Written Word prevents any carelessness or intentional departure from God's Truth, His perfect Will!

"Live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under law. The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying one another."

Gal. 5:16-26

"Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body. Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body."

I Cor. 6:18-20

"Among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. Nor should there be obscenity foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving. For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person ---such a man is an idolater—has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.....Be very careful, then, how you live---not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit."

Our culture today believes it is foolish to live by such spirit led rules. So many live daily to gratify the sinful nature. God has called us: "

Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord,...let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God."







