THE DAY GOD MAKES

For twenty-eight years, every school day I watched the sunrise. One of the blessings of driving the school bus was the beauty of God's earth being reflected by the sunlight. Most days in West Texas few clouds hide the sun. Out on the county roads the countryside was quiet as daybreak began to awaken the wildlife and people. It was a good way to begin my day. I knew that the Lord was providing another day.

Long ago the Psalmist wrote these words:

"This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it." (Psalms 118:24)

If we have faith in God as Creator, if we believe that he gives us life, breath and all things; then we can and will rejoice in another day. Life is precious. Life, even with all the difficulties, trauma and drama, will be worth living. The quality of our life is not based upon the circumstances we have, but rather our attitude and response.




Westworth Men's Group (monthly 1st & 3rd Tuesdays)
