Troubled Over Suffering In This World?

"I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33

"If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world. That is why the world hates you. Remember the words I spoke to you: 'No servant is greater than his master. If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also." John 15:18-20

Jesus did not mince any words about the trouble his followers would face. His subject was primarily that of rejection and actions of unbelievers. Persecution has always been part of Christian history. The Lord taught his disciples to expect it and prepare for it.

It was not just persecution that could be experienced. Putting the Lord first in life could bring some relationship problems, loss of security, and sacrificing earthly things. Check out Luke 9:57-62, Matt. 8:18-22, Luke 12:49-53 & 14:25-35. When we consider the many disruptions that faith can bring, there is struggle with it. We are emotionally attached to this life.

Jesus knows all about it. He suffered the hostility of others. He was truly a "Man of Sorrows". He wept at Lazarus' grave with his friends. He suffered in Gethsemane, as he faced Calvary. He was tempted to satisfy himself by turning stones to bread when he was hungry. He could have exalted himself in pride rather than humbly serving the Lord. He could have exchanged earth's glory for his faithfulness to the Father. He didn't! Why? So we can have his peace as we make our journey through this sinful and decaying world.




