Stand In Awe of God

""Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. Go near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools, who do not know that they do wrong. Do not be quick with your mouth, do not be hasty with your heart to utter anything before God. God is in heaven, and you are on earth, so let your words be few." Eccl. 5:1-2

In another place in his record of wisdom, warnings and teachings all who would follow him, he wrote: "Fear God and keep His commandments for this is the whole duty of man." (12:13). Today we read these words and recognize the great truth in them. If we will stand in awe of God, we must be among those who come before the Lord to listen and learn. We do not come before Him to offer anything that is within us, but rather to give praise and honor to Him.

I like what the author reminds us of: "God is in heaven, and you are on earth". It sets before us our place before the Almighty. Heaven is his place, and it will be ours if we live humbly before Him, offering the continual fruit of our lips that give Him the honor due. We are not equal. God loves us while we are still sinners. Sending Jesus to save us, He is our Redeemer and friend. Because of our humble state we bow down before Him and are in awe of our Creator.

When we leave the place of worship, do we live in reverence to the Lord Jesus? Is our daily life one that reflects the learning of His commands? Are we among those who live in such a way that no foolish vows will be made to the Lord? I plan each day to bring glory to God. Why? God is in heaven! He knows just what I do. His ways are higher than ours.

Put this on your calendar and bring ice cream (home made if possible) and accompanying items, and enjoy a summertime refresher as well as fellowship time.


July 20—3rd Sunday Lunch


