BEING ORDERLY AND RESPECTFUL IN CHURCH

"Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. Go near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools, who do not know tha "But everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way." Cor. 14:40

The congregation in the city of Corinth had many issues that the apostle Paul addresses in his letters to them. The first edition shares the fact that their worship in a public gathering was not very healthy. Fact was that the apostle said it would be best not to meet if they were treating one another as they were doing. It was not done in a respectful manner.

I suppose there will always be concerns and debate about what all was happening in the congregation then. What we do know about this troubling spirit in worship was that it should be done in a respectful way. Disorder was not an acceptable manner for the church. It would cause a division of thought and practice.

In another text the Scriptures say,

"Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace." Eph. 4:2

So then, we are instructed to form a common bond to let God's Spirit guide us in worship and the way and manner of worship.

The bond of peace is always centered upon our love for God. He has loved us so much by offering His Son, Jesus Christ to die on the cross for our sins. The greatest of commands is to: *"Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength."* Jesus said this is the first and greatest of commands. In our love for the Lord, we form a unity that is respectful of all who share with us the same love for Him who has saved us.

DONUTS AND DEVO'S (D&D)




Sundays at 9:00 am in the activity building.






Did you notice?
