Becoming Like Little Children

"At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, 'Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?' He called a little child and had him stand among them. And he said, 'I tell you the truth, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven." Matt. 18:1-4

While the apostles were concerned about who was the greatest in the kingdom, Jesus points them to the real need in their lives. They can be the greatest by being the humblest servant of all. This same message is given as they argued among themselves about the greatest. Jesus puts things into priority.

I would use this illustration for the purpose of sharing the truth about children. They are innocent and pure. Their conscience is clear. They are good. They have a spirit of humility that surrounds them.

When his apostles tried to prevent parents from bringing children to him, he rebuked the apostles and told them not to prevent the little ones from coming to him. He says that the kingdom of heaven belongs to them.

The news from Central Texas has greatly troubled us that so many children have been lost due to the flash flood. Prayers and ministries have been offered to the Father and on behalf of the families. Hurting alongside our neighbors is surely a blessing to those who are grieving. Let us be comforted by the assurance that the children are with Jesus. Keep these dates in mind. Before you know it,


those speed zones will be in effect again.


The Men's group continues to review and consider the concepts presented in this book. Many good conversations and biblical considerations are provoked when looking at things from someone else's viewpoint.
