Days of the Judges

"And the Sons of Israel departed from there at that time, every man to his tribe and family, and each one of them went out from there to his inheritance. In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes." Judges 21:24-25

With those words the Bible's book of Judges ends. It had not been long since the people of Jehovah had received their promised land by God's great provision. In that time, the people did what they thought was right from their own thought. They had no king. But the problem was not that they had no king. God would have directed their steps, but they were not giving heed to God's commands. Living in the days of the Judges would have been difficult.

Reading a recent article, my preacher friend was writing about the immorality of our day. He said it appeared we were now living like those in the days of The Judges. The moral code of God has been rejected, and people are living according to what they believe is right in their own eyes. This is the reason there are so many broken relationships and homes. 


In the hope that more men will be able to participate, The Men's group has decided to move to a virtual format, using Zoom meetings.
